Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2026 through fiscal year 2029 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

Background

The bill makes permanent emergency and temporary legislation that allows¹ pharmacists and pharmacy technicians in the District to order and administer immunizations recommended by competent medical and public health organizations² designated by the Director of the Department of Health (DC Health), in addition to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's published guidelines and recommended immunization schedules. The bill also makes conforming amendments to align the consent for vaccines for minors law with this new standard.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2026 through fiscal year 2029 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. DC Health can implement the permanent legislation without additional resources.
