Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2025 through fiscal year 2028 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

Background

DC Legendary Musicians, Inc. is a District-based nonprofit that preserves, protects, and promotes the artistic legacy, contributions, and well-being of the District's professional musicians.¹ The bill symbolically designates the alley that runs from S Street, N.W. to T Street, N.W. between Wiltberger Street, N.W. and 7th Street, N.W.² as DC Legendary Musicians Way.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2025 through fiscal year 2028 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. The District Department of Transportation will fabricate and install two signs to symbolically designate the roadway as DC Legendary Musicians Way. The signs, including poles, will cost \$920 and DDOT can absorb the cost within its existing budgeted resources.
