#### Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the proposed fiscal year 2021 through 2024 budget and financial plan to implement the resolution.

### **Background**

The resolution declares as surplus property the Ferebee-Hope School and Recreation Center located at 3999  $8^{th}$  Street S.E.<sup>1</sup>

The Department of General Services intends to enter into a 50-year ground lease with KIPP DC Public Charter Schools to redevelop the property for use as a charter school and a new recreation center. Separate legislation is pending to approve this disposition.

## **Financial Plan Impact**

Funds are sufficient in the proposed fiscal year 2021 thorough 2024 budget and financial plan to implement the resolution. There are no costs associated with the surplus property declaration.
