



Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the proposed revised fiscal year 2025 budget and proposed fiscal year 2026 through fiscal year 2029 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

Background

Reverend Dr. Judy Talbert was the pastor of Faith Tabernacle of Prayer who led several community organizations and efforts across the District, including aiding returning citizens, helping the homeless, working with gang members, and supporting individuals with HIV-AIDS. She ran the Joe Arthur Talbert, Jr. Foundation where she helped students achieve their goals of attending college. She served on President Barack Obama's National African American Clergy Network. Rev. Dr. Talbert died on August 19, 2018.

The bill symbolically designates Alabama Avenue, S.E. between Harford Street, S.E. and Gainesville Street, S.E. as Rev. Dr. Judy Talbert Way. The Faith Tabernacle of Prayer is located along this stretch of Alabama Avenue, S.E.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the proposed revised fiscal year 2025 budget and proposed fiscal year 2026 through fiscal year 2029 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will fabricate and install two signs to symbolically designate the roadway as
