

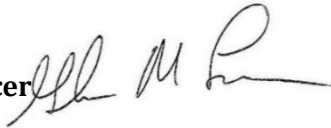

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2026 through fiscal year 2029 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

Background

Marvin “Slush” Gross was a young man who grew up in the District’s Barry Farm community in the 1990’s. Gross attended Anacostia High School and was an avid dancer with the Go-Go community, creating his own dance style known as Beat Ya Feet. Gross was killed on July 27, 2002 at twenty years old. Gross was recognized by the Council for his contributions to his community and status as a visionary artist on May 6, 2025.¹

The bill symbolically designates Sumner Road, S.E. as Marvin ‘Slush’ Gross Way.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2026 through fiscal year 2029 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will fabricate and install two

signs to symbolically designate the roadway as Marvin 'Slush' Gross Way. The signs will cost \$370 and DDOT can absorb the cost within its existing budgeted resources.
