Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2022 budget and fiscal year 2023 through fiscal year 2026 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

Background

The bill redesignates the street known as Ellen Wilson Place, S.E.¹, in Ward 6, as Navy Place S.E.

The bill also changes the notice requirement for official street naming to allow an approved resolution by the Advisory Neighborhood Commission to substitute for the posting of signage about the proposed change in the neighborhood.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2022 budget and fiscal year 2023 through fiscal year 2026 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. Signage for the new street name will cost \$570, which DDOT can absorb within its existing budget.
