



Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2026 through fiscal year 2029 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

Background

Roland ‘Fatty’ Taylor was a professional basketball player born in Washington, DC who grew up in the East Capitol Dwellings public housing complex and attended Spingarn High School. Fatty Taylor played in both the American Basketball Association (ABA) and the National Basketball Association (NBA). Fatty Taylor played in the ABA for seven seasons with the Washington Capitols, Virginia Squires, and Denver Nuggets. He played one season with the Denver Nuggets when they joined the NBA in 1976.

The bill symbolically designates 62nd Street, N.E. from Banks Place, N.E. to Clay Street, N.E. as Roland ‘Fatty’ Taylor Way.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2026 through fiscal year 2029 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will fabricate and install two signs to symbolically designate the roadway as Roland ‘Fatty’ Taylor Way. The signs will cost \$255 and DDOT can absorb the cost within the agency’s existing budgeted resources.
