### Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the budget and financial plan. The effect of the committee print retains current law, so it does not affect the budget and financial plan.

## **Background**

The Utilizing Partnerships and Local Interventions for Truancy and Safety (UPLIFT) Amendment Act of 2024 was introduced on April 11, 2024, on behalf of the Mayor.¹ Titles I, II, and III of the Act were referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Public Safety.² Titles I, II, and III change public safety requirements and the operations of the Department of Youth Rehabilitation Services when youth are charged with a crime of violence.

The committee print of Titles I, II, and III of the bill strikes the proposed language in its entirety.

## **Financial Plan Impact**

The effect of the committee print retains current law. Thus, it has no fiscal impact.
