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**Conclusion**

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2026 through fiscal year 2029 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

**Background**

The bill allows<sup>1</sup> the Chair of the Council committee with oversight over the Department of Youth Rehabilitation Services (DYRS) and the Child and Family Services Agency (CFSA), as well as the Office of the Ombudsperson for Children (OFC), to access delinquency, need for supervision, and neglect case files when necessary for the discharge of their duties.

**Financial Plan Impact**

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2026 through fiscal year 2029 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. CFSA and DYRS can provide the Chair of the Council Committee on Youth Affairs and OFC with access to delinquency, need of supervision, and neglect case files without additional resources.
