



Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2024 through fiscal year 2027 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

Background

Blue & White Marching Machine is Eastern High School's marching band. The band has marched in NFL halftime shows, presidential inaugural parades, and the opening ceremony for the FIFA World Cup. During practices, the band typically marches along A Street, N.E., from Eastern High School, located at 1700 East Capitol Street, N.E., to Lincoln Park.

The bill symbolically designates A Street, N.E. between North Carolina Avenue, N.E. and 17th Street, N.E. as Blue & White Marching Machine Way.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2024 through fiscal year 2027 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will need to fabricate and install eight signs and one pole to symbolically designate the roadway as Blue & White Marching Machine Way. The signs and pole will cost \$1,790 and DDOT can absorb the cost within its existing budgeted resources.
