Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2011 through FY 2014 budget and financial plan to implement the proposed legislation.

Background

The proposed legislation would amend the District of Columbia Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010¹ (“Act”) to exempt the Mayor from the requirements of the Act with regards to procuring the design, development, and construction services needed for a new fire station and office space for the D.C. Fire and Emergency Medical Services Department to be constructed on real property located at Butternut Street and Georgia Avenue, N.W. at the Walter Reed Army Medical Center.

Fiscal Impact

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2011 through FY 2014 budget and financial plan to implement the proposed legislation. Exempting the procurement of certain services from the requirements of the District’s procurement laws and regulations would have no impact on the District’s budget and financial plan.
